A tribute to the annual Gran Fondo King ridge bike race in Sonoma County, this wine is a blend two appellations and three different clones of Pinot noir: 667, 777 and Pommard. This wine shows a very floral aroma with rose petals and sweet cherry. Aged in 35% new French oak, the mouth feel is that of soft tannins and sweet oaky vanilla. Vinted in a Burgundian style, The fruitiness of the wine is balanced by the subtle French oak.
