Grown in a very small vineyard on the eastern edge of the Russian River Valley, this wine presents a bright fruit punch red color with aromas of fresh black cherries, blue raspberry, red fruit, some green vegetable and spice. Not too heavy on the palate, fruity acidity and soft chalky tannins coat the mouth. The wine finishes with a lingering lemony acid and more red fruit.
